

Event Terms and Conditions – Medway’s Hospital Heroes Run.

General:

- The booking terms and conditions apply to everyone participating in the Medway’s Hospital Heroes 5K Run on 23 June 2019, and those who attend as spectators. Upon registering for the event, you agree to the terms and conditions below.
- All participants are responsible for their own medical condition/s. Should you have a medical condition, or if you are in any doubt about your ability to participate and finish the run, please seek medical advice prior to the event.
- Places are limited in Medway’s Hospital Heroes Run event and entries are processed in the order received.
- The closing date for entries is Friday 21 June at 12pm. All participants wishing to take part after this time will need to sign up and pay on the day.
- Under-16s MUST book with, and be accompanied by an adult. Children cannot take part alone and must run with a parent, or another adult, with parental/guardian consent.
- If you are registering as a team, each participant will need to complete individual registration forms.
- Participants will be filmed and photographed throughout the Hospital Heroes Run. Images and/or footage may be used on promotional materials in print, online and on social media to promote The Medway Hospital Charity. It is the responsibility of the participant to let organisers know if they do not wish to be filmed or photographed by the organisers.
- If you are bringing a dog to run with you at the event, they must be kept on a leash and are the dog owner is responsible for its behaviour.

Payments:

- The entry fee is non-refundable and non-transferable.
- There is no minimum sponsorship required to take part, but we do encourage you to do your best to raise as much money as possible.
- Medway’s Hospital Heroes Run is organised by The Medway Hospital Charity to raise money for Medway Maritime Hospital. We ask that all sponsorship raised is for Medway Maritime Hospital. Please do not raise money for other charities, trusts or funds.

Changes to the event:

- The Medway Hospital Charity cannot be held liable for any changes made to the event for safety reasons or difficult weather conditions, or as otherwise planned through circumstances beyond their control. Nor can they accept any liability for any changes made to the venue or date of the event.

Cancellation:

- The Medway Hospital Charity reserves the right to cancel this event at any time. In the event of this happening, entry fees and sponsorship will be refunded in full.

Clothing and storing personal items:

- Due to the theme of the Hospital Heroes Run, all participants are encouraged to dress up in their favourite comic or super hero costume. The Medway Hospital Charity is not responsible for supplying costumes to participants, nor for any damage, wear or tear to such items.
- There will be no changing or bag drop facilities at the event, other than nearby public toilets, so any items will be left at your own risk.

Medals:

- Medals are subject to availability and cannot be guaranteed for people registering on the day.

Great Lines Heritage Park:

- Please be aware that the venue is a public park and will still be open to the general public.
- There are likely to be other visitors such as pedestrians, dog walkers and cyclists around during the event, so we do ask that you take this into consideration on the day and remember it's not a race, but a fun run to raise much-needed funds for The Medway Hospital Charity.

Data Protection:

- For the purposes of the event, personal information will be collected and may include medical data collected for health and safety purposes.
- Personal information will be stored, used by the event organiser and their partners in connection with the organisation, staging and administration of the event. It will not be sold to other organisations.
